Panama City Police Department Investigation Narrative On 09/10/2016 I responded to 2405 Stanford Road for an agency assist. Upon arrival, Myself and Ofc. Abraham made contact with a white female who was being seen by EMS. During their conversation she advised she was not having a emergency medical problem and refused to be transported to the hospital by them. I asked her for her identification when she identified herself as FBI special agent Gina D Pitts. Ofc. Abraham asked Ms. Pitts if she was in the FBI and she replied "yes you can check the computer". Ofc. Abraham asked Ms. Pitts did she any identification identifying her as an agent with the FBI and she replied it's in the computer. Ms. Pitts was then asked if she was a Federal Police Officer and she replied "yes". Ms. Pitts was asked by Ofc. Abraham if she classify's herself as a police officer with arrest powers and she replied "yes I have the power of arrest". Pitts stated Stop I will arrest you and you are under arrest. Myself and Ofc. Abraham attempted to place Ms. Pitts under arrest for impersonating a Police Officer when she began resisting arrest by pulling away and clinching her arms in an attempt to stop us from placing her into handcuffs. Ms. Pitts then began yelling that she was pregnant and kept turning away from us again preventing us from placing her into handcuffs. After a short struggle Ms. Pitts was placed into double locked handcuff in the front for her because her her possible pregnancy. She was escorted to my marked patrol car where she was placed in the back seat without further incident. I transported Pitts to the Bay County Jail without incident. Panama City Police Department Investigation Narrative While driving south on Hwy 390 approaching Baldwin Rd., I observed a black vehicle, a 2007 Lexus with FL EFVQ25, in the ditch on the West side of the road. I exited my vehicle and made contact with the sole occupant, Ashley Summer Douglas. She was sitting in the drivers seat, taking a picture of a plastic glass that was on the passenger side floor. I knocked on the driver's window and made contact with the sole occupant Ashley Summer Douglas, who was in the driver's seat. Douglas asked, "How'd you get here?". I asked Douglas if she was injured or had any medical conditions. She replied no. Douglas stated she was coming from Lynn Haven and driving to the Beach. She then stated she parked her car where it was located and that she was in Vernon. The entire time speaking with Douglas, her speech was slurred and her motor skills were slow. Her account of where she was going and how she ended up in the ditch changed numerous times. PCPD dispatched advised the area I was located was BCSO's jurisdiction and I requested they respond. BCSO arrived on scene and it was shortly determined that FHP would need to respond for the possibility of Douglas driving under the influence.
