

# POLICE REPORT LYNN HAVEN PD



Incident # 16-09944

On 09/08/16 at approximately 0030 hours, Ofc. Radcliff and I were doing foot patrol at the Pinehurst and Briarwood apartment complexes.

While on foot I observed two black males standing by a vehicle in the parking lot near the L building in Briarwood. The two black males identified themselves as Brayun Harris and Stephen Douglas. Douglas stated they were visiting his brother who lives in L 246.

I advised both subjects about the curfew after 10 p.m. both stated they didn't know they were just smoking a cigarette.

Dispatch checked both subjects through NLETS. Shortly after dispatch advised Douglas had a local warrant dated on 08/18/14, for failure to pay fine on suspension of his driver license.

I advised Douglas of the warrant and secured him in double locked handcuffs. Douglas stated several times that he didn't do anything wrong and didn't know why he was being arrested.

I explained to Douglas what the warrant was for. Douglas then stated he didn't know he had a warrant and shouldn't be arrested for something he didn't know about.

Harris was advised he could go back to the apartment that he was visiting.

As I escorted Douglas to my marked patrol car, he stated he knew he was going to be arrested as soon as he saw Ofc. Radcliff and I. I asked him why he thought that.

**Douglas further stated it was because he was a black guy in a black community and that was why he was being arrested.**

I explained to him if he didn't have a warrant he would have never been arrested.

I conducted a search of Douglas' person with negative results. I then placed Douglas in the backseat of my marked patrol car and transported him to the Bay County Jail without incident. The booking sheet and a copy of the warrant is attached to this case. **LHPD OFFICER DINSE**



Incident # 16-10071

On 9-12-2016 at 0750 I was dispatched to the intersection of SR 390 and Pennsylvania Avenue in reference to a traffic crash

Upon arrival I made contact with the driver of vehicle one, Brandie M Davis, and the passenger of vehicle 1, John Christopher Casey. Davis and Casey stated that they were traveling south on Pennsylvania Avenue and stopped at the intersection at SR 390. Davis and Casey said they tried to cross at the intersection but their vision was obstructed by a tractor trailer.

Davis and Casey stated they attempted to cross and collided with vehicle 2, which was passing to the left of the semi to get into the left turn lane at the intersection of SR 77.

The driver of vehicle 2, Gabriel Duchae Parker, said that she was traveling west on SR 390 and went around a tractor trailer to

get into the turn lane at SR 390 and SR 77, which is a no passing zone. Parker said she could not see around the tractor trailer and was struck by vehicle 1 when it attempted to cross 390 on Pennsylvania Avenue.

During the course of the crash investigation it was discovered Davis had a suspended driver license. Davis was unable to provide a registration for the vehicle and stated she had no insurance.

The tag displayed on vehicle 1, Florida GHI-K52, returned to a Nissan SUV registered to Davis with an expiration of 04-02-2016. A check by VIN of vehicle 1 showed a different tag registered to Eric J. Rogers. Sergeant Nusbaum, who was also on scene, advised Davis admitted to putting the tag on the vehicle. Vehicle 1 was towed by Gulf County Towing due to damage and incident to arrest. The tag was seized for return to DHSMV.

Vehicle 2 was registered to PV Holding Corp and displayed a Massachusetts tag, 4CJ774. Vehicle 2 was driven by Gabriel Duchae Parker. All information for this vehicle and driver was current and valid. Side airbags were deployed in vehicle 2 and was towed by Hometown towing due to damage.

Davis was issued criminal citations for driving while license suspended or revoked with knowledge, citation number A0HICCP, attaching a tag not assigned, A1Z9UUP, no insurance, A1Z9UVP, and a civil citation for violation of right of way at a stop sign intersection, A1Z9UWP.

Davis was taken into custody on the criminal violations, placed in double locked handcuffs, and secured in the back Corporal Landingham's patrol vehicle. Davis was transported to the Bay County Jail and turned over to their staff without incident.

Parker was transported to Gulf Coast Medical Center by EMS for minor injuries, was treated and released. Parker later came to the Lynn Haven Police Department and retrieved her driver license and vehicle information. Parker was issued a civil citation for passing in a no passing zone, A1Z9UXP. **LHPD OFFICER BIRGENHEIER**
