## Loitering Panama City Police Department Investigation Narrative

On 8/27/16, while I was patrolling the 1000 Block of E. 5th Street, I noticed a white female sleeping on the sidewalk on the eastern side of the Watson Bayou Bridge. I made contact with the female who was identified as Rachael Campbell. Our department had received multiple calls from citizens about her sleeping and laying on the sidewalk over the past two or three days. Officers had made contact with her multiple times as well to ensure her welfare as well as to ask her to move along. I had made contact with her on 8/26/16 and asked her to move along. At this time, I requested that she move along or I would take her into custody for violating a city ordinance.



Campbell stated that the only way she was going to leave is if I took her to jail. At this time I took Campbell into custody and transported her to the Bay County Jail for Sitting and Laying on a Sidewalk (MO 20-12). Campbell had two bags with her which were also taken and turned over to jail staff. It should be noted that Campbell advised that when she got out of jail that she was going to return to that spot and continue sleeping there, therefore, this could be a reoccurring issue with this individual.

## PROWLER



On August 27, 2016, at approximately 7:00 P.M., I was dispatched to Life Management Center, located at 525 E 15th St, in reference to a suspicious person. Upon my arrival, I made contact with a white male, later identified as Aaron Lowe, hunched over the passenger side window of a gold four door passenger car located at the east side of building A. Once I made contact with Lowe, I observed his fingers were placed in a small crack in the window as if he were attempting to gain entry inside the vehicle. At this time, I detained Lowe pending further investigation. Post Miranda, I asked Lowe why he was at the closed business next to an unoccupied vehicle. Lowe reported, his friend "Doug" owned the vehicle and he was

waiting for Doug to come back so they could leave. I ran the registration FL/X9612B and found the vehicle was registered to Life Management Center. I advised Lowe a worker in the area had called stating he observed Lowe wandering the area and attempting to gain entry into vehicles. Lowe would not respond to my questions and appeared to be under the influence of an unknown controlled substance. The complainant was identified as Christopher Morris. Morris is a contract worker for Life Management and was working on the roof when he observed Lowe in the area. Morris provided a written statement of his accounts of the incident. Due to Lowe being unable to dispel my concern for the safety of property in the area, he was charged with Loitering and Prowling. Lowe was transported to the Bay County Jail without incident.

At approximately 9:16 PM, I was sitting stationary near the intersection of Balboa Avenue on West 15th Street when I observed a grey 4 door car driving exceedingly faster than the normal flow of traffic. Upon seeing the vehicle pass multiple cars, I entered the roadway and began to try and catch up to the car. At approximately the Dodge's gas station, I began to pace the vehicle which I observed to be bearing a Texas license plate. At this time I was travelling at 55 miles per hour, and the vehicle continued to pull away from me at over 55 miles per hour in a 45 mph zone. At the intersection of Frankford Avenue, I caught up to the vehicle which I identified to be an older model Audi A4. I finally identified the vehicle to bearing Texas license plate "BV1W702". At this time I activated my blue, overhead emergency lights and conducted a lawful traffic stop due to the vehicle's excessive

speed. The vehicle continued to travel westbound on West 15th Street but finally stopped at the intersection of Arthur Avenue. I made contact with the driver of the vehicle who was identified as Jorge Gallo-Reynoso by his Mexican passport. Gallo-Reynoso immediately stated to me he did not have a driver license, but he did have the vehicle's registration and insurance for the vehicle. Upon hearing Gallo-Reynoso did not have a driver license, I detained him in double locked handcuffs and placed him in the back of my patrol car. While in my marked patrol car, Gallo-Reynoso made several excited utterances stating he may have been speeding at the time I stopped him. I confirmed Gallo-Reynoso did not have a valid driver license, nor had he ever had one, but had been issued a Florida driver license number, which was suspended. A rotation wrecker was called to remove Gallo-Reynoso's vehicle from the scene. The Audi was inventoried and released to Garrett's towing without incident. Gallo-Reynoso was transported to the Bay County Jail for DWLSR and was issued a traffic citation for F.S.S. 316.074(1). Gallo-Reynoso was released to jail staff without incident
