

DRUNK DRIVER

Panama City Police Department Investigation Narrative

On 08/26/2016, I responded to the area of Hwy 98 and Danford Ave. in reference to a to small black truck driving recklessly on the roadway. The passerby who called, also reported the truck pulled over by the Kangaroo Gas Station and the male and female occupants appeared to be in a physical altercation. Officers arrived on scene and made contact with the occupants, Steven Cripe and Meleah Carter. Cripe was in the driver's seat and Carter



in the passengers.

Both were highly intoxicated. They claimed they were looking for the key to the truck. I did notice the vehicle was not running and there was no key in the ignition. After further investigation, it was determined no physical violence had occurred between the two. I advised both they were too intoxicated to drive. I advised them to find a sober driver or call a taxi to take them home. I then advised them I will be parking across the street to wait until they could get a ride. I repeatedly warned both not to drive or they would be arrested for DUI. I parked across the street in a conspicuous spot and maintained visual contact. Moments later Cripe got into the driver's seat, started the truck and drive the vehicle north on Danford Ave. where he pulled into the Kangaroo Gas Store. I pulled up behind them and made contact with Cripe and conducted a DUI investigation. Cripe refused to perform FSE's and to provide a sample of his breath. Cripe was arrested for DUI and transported to the Bay County Jail without incident. The vehicle was removed from the scene by Garrett's Wrecker Service.

On Saturday August 27th 2016 around 12:07

a.m. I responded to 621 East 4th Court in reference to a subject causing a disturbance. I arrived and met with Mr. Elkins. He stated that they had been letting Peterson stay at this location for a short time. He stated that tonight Peterson came in and passed out on the floor after he asked him to find another location in the house to sleep. Peterson began cussing him and he told him to just leave the house. Peterson refused to leave and Mr. Elkins called the police to have him removed. I was able to wake Peterson up and informed him that he needed to leave that he was no longer welcome at this house. Peterson had to be told several times to leave and argued about leaving but eventually left the residence and the property. I informed him not to return. Around 12:48 a.m. I responded back to this location in reference to Peterson returning. As I arrived I observed Peterson on the property. Peterson again was informed to leave the property or he would be arrested. Peterson stated "Fu** them and fu** you just take me to jail". At that time I placed Peterson under arrest for trespassing. Peterson was transported to the Bay County Jail where he was turned over to jail staff. A witness statement was obtained from Mr. Elkins stating that he had told Peterson to leave.

Drugs -2 ARRESTED

On 8/27/16, 2:14am, I observed a blue Toyota pickup truck bearing Florida tag GCQH79 traveling westbound on 15th St at the intersection of Frankford Ave with one functioning headlight. I conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle at the intersection of 15th St and Foster Ave. Upon making contact with the driver/registered owner, Silden



Carpenter, I advised him of the infraction and he provided his Florida Driver License as identification. Upon completing the traffic stop I returned Mr. Carpenter's documentation and issued him a citation for Failure to Change Address on Driver License. While speaking

with Mr. Carpenter I asked him for verbal consent to search his vehicle.

Mr. Carpenter gave me verbal consent to search his vehicle. Upon searching the vehicle I asked the passenger of the vehicle, Kayla Davis, to exit the vehicle. Upon searching the passenger seat of the vehicle I located a clear plastic baggy with a Batman symbol on it containing a clear plastic baggy with a crystal substance inside. Upon conducting a field test of the substance it yielded positive result for Methamphetamine. The baggy was located in the passenger seat in plain sight where Ms. Davis was located. Upon searching the driver side of the vehicle I located a clear plastic baggy with a Batman symbol on it containing a small amount of a green leafy substance. Upon conducting a field test of the substance it yielded a positive result for Marijuana. The Marijuana was located between the driver seat and the center console with a tin foil smoking pipe. I located a metal spoon with a crystal substance on it in the sunglass compartment located on the center of the roof of the vehicle. Upon conducting a field test of the substance it yielded a positive result for Methamphetamine. Mr. Carpenter was placed under lawful arrest and into the rear of my marked patrol vehicle. After being read Miranda Warnings Mr. Carpenter stated the bag of Marijuana belongs to him.



Mr. Carpenter stated the bag of Methamphetamine belongs to Ms. Davis.

Ms. Davis was placed under lawful arrest and into the rear of Ofc. Walker's marked patrol vehicle. Upon being read Miranda Warnings Ms. Davis stated she was not aware she was sitting on the bag of Methamphetamine.

Mr. Carpenter was transported to the Bay County Jail for Possession of Controlled Substance, Possession of Marijuana less than 20 grams, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Ms. Davis was transported to the Bay County Jail for Possession of Controlled Substance and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. The vehicle was released to Gulf County Wrecker Service.
