84. NARRATIVE OF THE FACTUAL BASIS FOR PROBABLE CAUSE: The undersigned certifies that he / she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the heretofore named defendant did commit the violation as stated above and the factual basis for belief is as follows:

On August 27, 2016 the Bay County Sheriff's Office was contacted by the victim, Brittany Duffy, who advised the defendant, Jeffery Murray took her vehicle on August 24, 2016 and has not returned the vehicle. The vehicle is a 2014 Toyota Corrola which is registered to Brittany and her mother. Brittany advised she has contacted Murray multiple times about him bringing the vehicle back to her but he did not return the vehicle. Brittany advised she did not give Murray permission to take her vehicle and he did so while she was in the shower.

This vehicle was located by Deputy McKenzie on August 29, 2016 being driven by Zachary Clark while present with Jeffery Murray and James Glass. Zachary provided a statement that Jeffery showed up to a residence he was at this morning in Callaway and asked him to drive the vehicle since he did not have a license to drive.

Murray was in custody in the back of Deputy Fairclothes car and when I opened the door he made the spontaneous statement that "she is gonna drop the charge" referring to Duffy. I explained to Murray that Duffy had provided a statement about him not having her authorization to possess the vehicle so he was being arrested for Grand Theft Auto.

This is in violation of FSS 812.014 Grand Theft Auto. This offense did occur in Bay County, Florida.
