## BURGLARY *the pills, cord and jumper cables were gone*

On 8/26/16, I was dispatched to 3100 E. 11th Street, in reference to a larceny. I made contact with the complainant, Eddie Zimmerman, who claimed he had 80 Neurontin pills, an extension cord and jumper cables taken out of his vehicle. He claimed he went to a Walmart with a white male, who he only knew as "Danny", and two white females he had only known since this morning. He stated that Danny and the two females stayed in the vehicle while he went inside and when he came out of the Walmart that the pills, cord and jumper cables were gone. He could not advise when he last saw the three other individuals and could not remember if they were in the vehicle when he returned. It should be noted that Zimmerman could not remember what Walmart he was at, Danny's last name or the names of the two females. He claimed he met all three of the individuals this morning. It should be noted that his story would change each time I asked him about the events.

## SHOPLIFTER

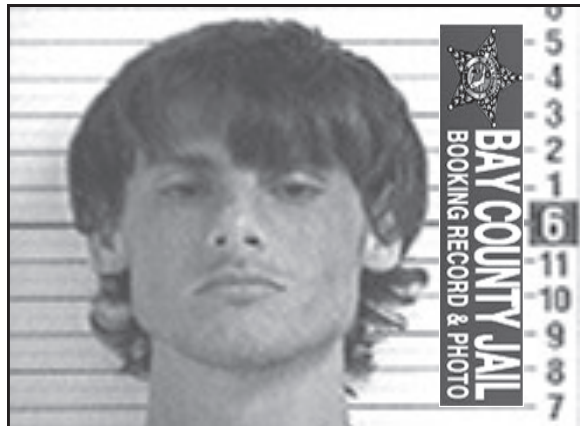

On August 26, 2016, at approximately 7:40 P.M., I responded to Walmart, located at 513

W 23rd St, in reference to a shoplifter in custody. Upon my arrival, I made contact with loss prevention employee, Thomas Taylor. Taylor reported a white male, later identified as Phillip Norris, had been observed inside the store selecting a pair of shoes from the shoe department, placing them on his feet and walking around the store. Norris was observed selecting a bottled soda from a cooler, opening it and consuming it. Norris past all points-of-sale and attempted to exit the building with the shoes and drink still in his possession. Norris was stopped by Taylor and escorted to the LP office. At this time, I asked Norris for his identification, however, he stated he didn't have it on him.

**I asked Norris for his name and date of birth. Norris replied, "My name is James O. Norris and my birthday is September 18, 1994."**

Norris stated his ID was out of Troy Alabama, however, Teletype advised the name was not returning.



**I advised Norris of the issue and asked if he wanted to provide me with his real name. Norris replied, "My name is Phillip B. Norris and my birthday is 09/18/1995."**

The updated information was run through Teletype and positive identification was made.

I secured Norris in double locked handcuffs and escorted him to my patrol vehicle. A search of Norris revealed a unopened bag of Jolly Ranchers candy and cold medicine in his front pockets. All UPC's returned to Walmart

and were added to the case. Taylor signed a Trespass Warning and Property Return Form. Norris was transported to the Bay County Jail without incident. Norris was charged with Retail Theft and Providing a False Name to LEO.

## DRUNK DRIVER

On August 26, 2016, at approximately 10:28 P.M., I was dispatched to the Holiday Inn, located at 2001 MLK Blvd, in reference to a disturbance. Upon my arrival, I made contact with the complainant/manager, Dave Tyring. Tyring reported, a white male, approximately 6 ft tall with brown hair, had been verbally assaulting customers and staff inside the lounge. Tyring stated the male was extremely intoxicated and was mad about being cut off from the bar. Tyring reported, the male was in town for business and had an 18 wheeler parked out front, however, when Tyring called police, the male went back towards his room inside the hotel. I was unable to locate the subject upon arrival. A few moments later, while standing outside of the lobby, I was approached by a guest of the hotel who stated the white male that had been harassing everyone inside was now stumbling through the parking lot towards the 18 wheeler. At this time, I relocated to the 18 wheeler that was parked on the southeast side of the parking lot. As I approached, the truck engine turned on and the brake lights activated. I approached the driver side door and observed a white male with brown hair sitting in the driver seat. The driver identified himself as, Nedim Valjevic. After making contact was made with Nedim, several indicators were observed that his normal faculties were impaired. I advised Nedim of my suspicion he was under the influence of alcohol and asked him to stand on a white parking line. Nedim stated, "I'm not f\*\*\*ing doing that."

Nedim was placed under arrest for DUI, secured in double locked handcuffs and placed in the back of my patrol car. Nedim was read Implied Consent and he refused to provide a sample of his breath. Nedim was transported to the Bay County jail without incident.
